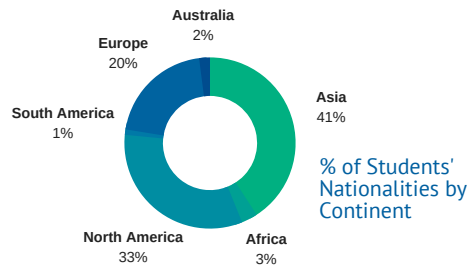
HIGH SCHOOL PROFILE

School Community

The High School has an enrollment of approximately 800 students from 70 countries. Our campus, accommodating approximately 3,000 students, is a purpose built facility with leading edge amenities to support student development. The parents of DAA students come from a variety of business, governmental and other professional backgrounds..



Academic Program

DAA provides a college-preparatory educational program. The language of instruction is English. Students enroll in a maximum of eight courses in a 4X4 block alternating Day 1/Day 2 schedule. Graduation requirements include a minimum of 22 credits and community service for each year at DAA. Students are also given the option to enroll in the full International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma, IB Certificate courses, and Advanced Placement (AP) classes.

School Calendar

Our school year, consisting of two semesters, runs from early September to the end of June.

Graduation Requirements

22 credits are required for graduation and credit is issued by semester. One-half credit (0.5) is awarded for the successful completion of each semester course with a minimum passing mark of D-. One credit (1.0) is awarded for the successful completion of each full year course passed. Specific credit requirements are as follows:

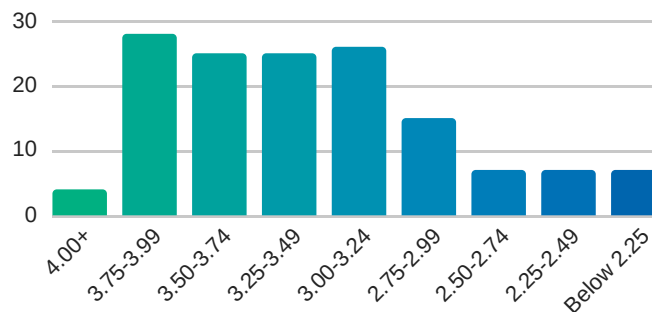

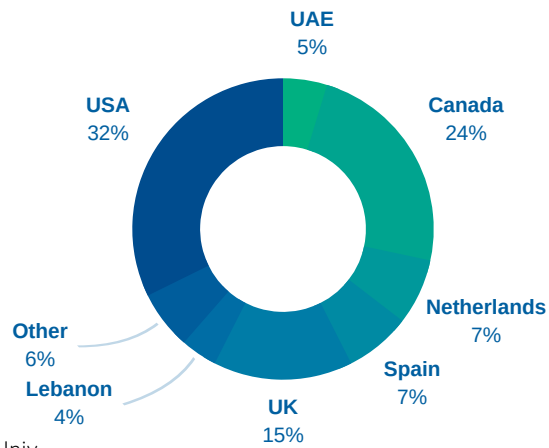
