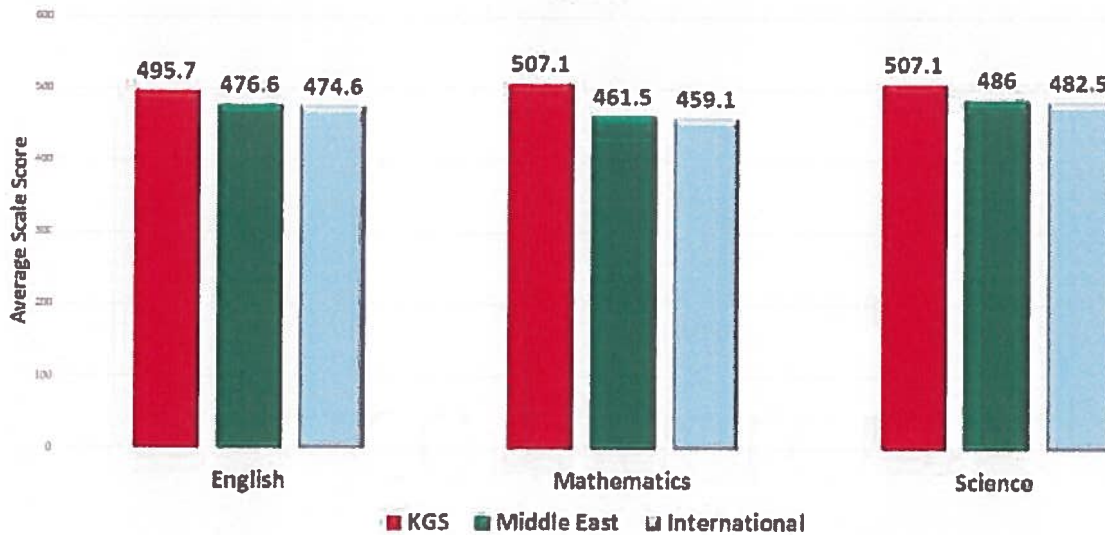

2016-17**



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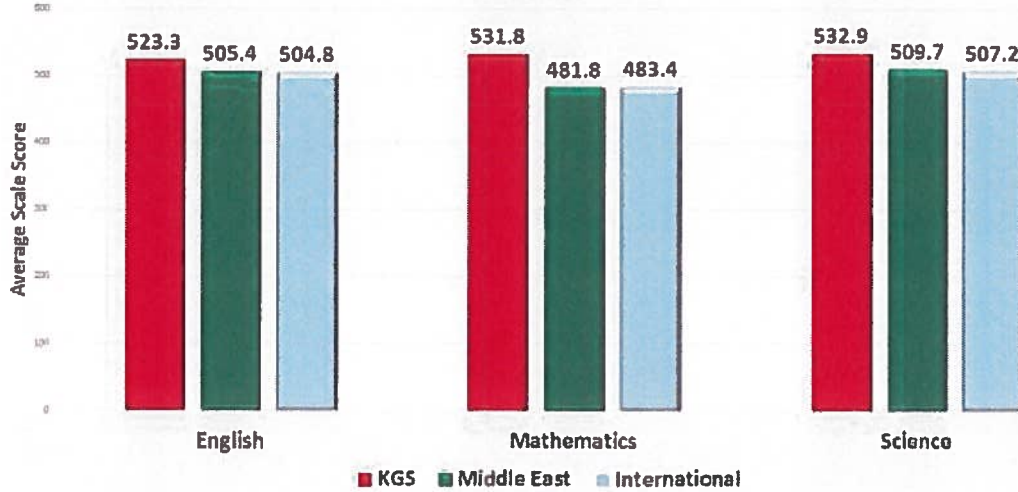


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I convey my congratulations to all the students for this absolutely splendid performance and thank the teachers and parents who have worked together to raise student outcomes at our school.

IBT Student Report Guide

The IBT Student Report is a detailed report on a student’s overall performance on the test. It highlights strengths and weaknesses in each strand/skill area and provides comparisons to other students in the country or region and to all students internationally who took the test. Scale scores allow progress to be monitored from one year to the next. This document explains each section of the report.

Performance on Each Question

- Shows which questions were answered correctly or incorrectly.
- Lists the content and strand for each question.

- Provides a score for each strand and the raw score (total questions correct) for the test.
- Compares percentage of questions correct to the average for other students in the country/region and to all schools internationally.

Percentile Rank

- The percentile rank shows where the student is placed within the group of students who took the test.
- This is shown for the student within the group of students who took the test at the school, in the country/region and in the group of all students internationally who took the test.
- This example shows a higher rank of 66.7 within the school group and lower rank of 58.5 within the group of all students internationally who took the test.

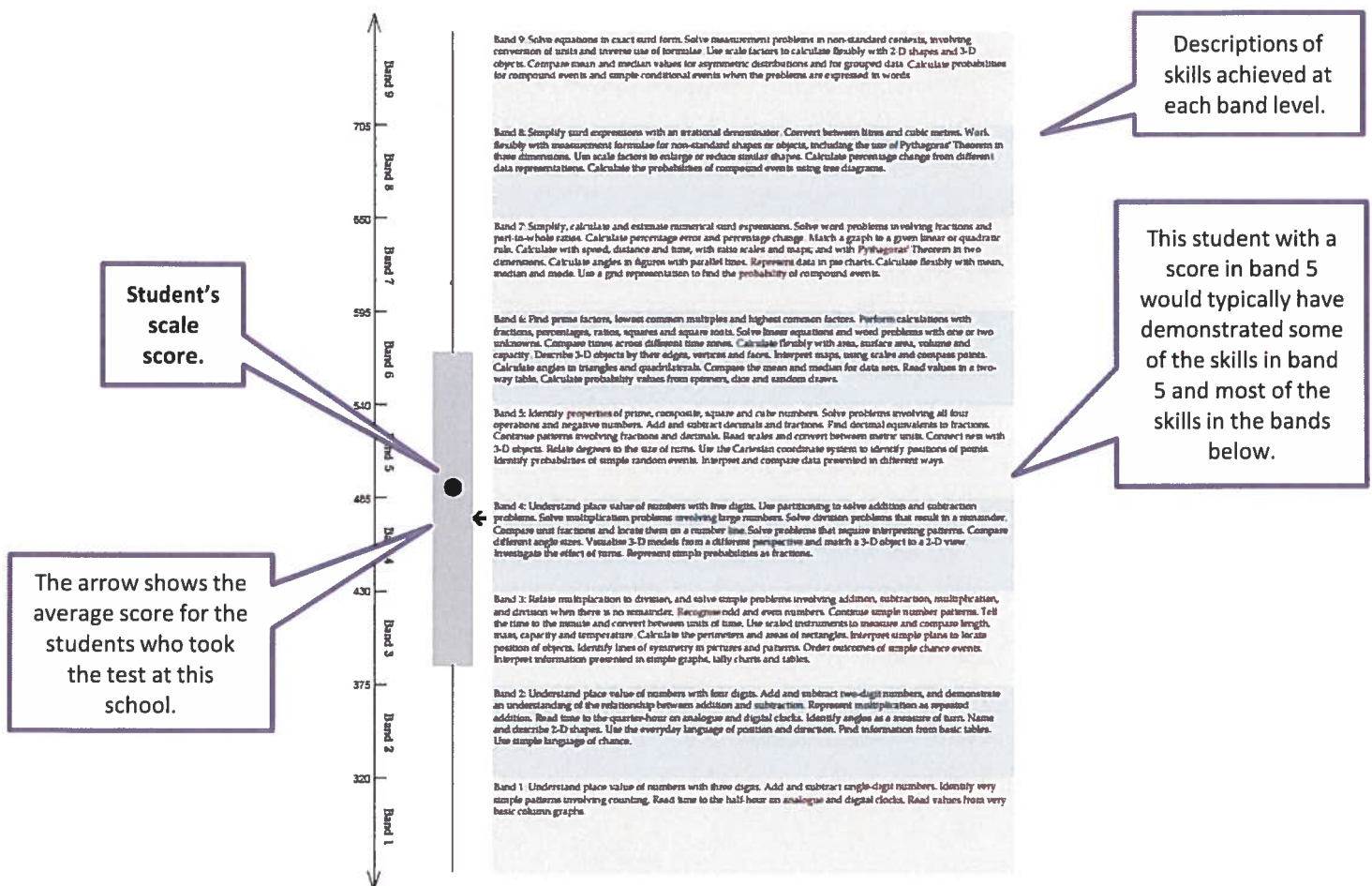

Compare the student's scale score to the average score in your school, country/region, and internationally.

- There is a described scale for each IBT subject – English, Mathematics, Science – see further information under Described Achievement below.
- ACER undertakes psychometric analyses to convert raw scores (total correct answers) to a location on the subject scale which is called a 'scale score'.
- This allows scores for different tests to be compared between grades levels and over time.
- For example the scale score for IBT English in 2015 can be directly compared to the IBT English scale score in 2016 to see how a student has progressed (even though the tests have different questions).

Described Achievement

- The described achievement chart shows the student's result on the described scale.
- The 'bands' on the scale have descriptions of the skills and understandings achieved at that level. The lowest set of skills is in the bottom band and the highest in the top band.
- This example shows a student with a result in band 5. Read the band description to see the skills and understandings achieved at this level.
- Compare to last year's result on the scale to see how a student has progressed.
