

Dear Parents,

Last working day and re-opening day before and after the winter break: -

The School will remain closed for the winter break from Sunday, 16th December 2018 to Thursday, 27th December 2018. School reopens on Sunday, 30th December 2018.

The last working day before the winter break for the students from KG1 to Grade 5 is Thursday, 13th December 2018. Students will have a class party from the 3rd period onwards on this day. Please send the school calendar, books for the first three periods, extra snacks and a water bottle. Students can come in coloured clothes.

Grades I to V students will have classes up to 12:00 noon only and will reach home 2 hours earlier than the normal time (along with KG students). **Since all students will be boarding the bus at 12:00 noon, there might be a slight delay in the KG drop off timings.**

All Own Transport children need to be collected before 12:15 p.m. on Thursday, 13th December, 2018.

AAA Activities and Day Care Facility:-

Please note that the last day for AAA activities for Grades 1 to 5 for this term would be Wednesday, 12th December, 2018. AAA activities will resume after the winter break on Sunday, 6th January 2019.

Day Care Facility for KG1 and KG2 will be ongoing till Thursday, 13th December, 2018 and resume after the winter break on Sunday, 30th December 2018.

School Office timings during the winter break: -

The school office will remain open for administrative purposes during the winter break from Sunday, 16th December 2018 to Thursday, 27th December 2018 (except: Fridays, Saturdays and Christmas Day), giving parents the opportunity to:

1. Enquire about student vacancies
2. Pay outstanding fees
3. Pre-pay fees for the next term

We urge parents to take advantage of the quiet period to make payments. Office timings will be from 8:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. during the winter break. You could also avail the online facility to pay fees.
