Dear Parents,

The school uniform is our pride. When learners respect their uniform it is a reflection of their pride and commitment towards their school.

Please be informed that there will be regular daily and weekly checks on smart uniform turn out. The Dress code is being reiterated so as to ensure clarity and consistency in expectations.

DRESS CODE @ KGS

- Students are expected to maintain a smart turnout and be well groomed always.
- Parents must ensure that their children come to school neatly dressed.
- Parents need to ensure that their wards wear clean and ironed uniforms at all times.
- Shirts must be tucked in at all times.
- Ties are to be worn at all times except during the peak summer months of May and June. Worn out ties do not look smart and will be confiscated.
- The school cardigan to be worn during winter, no other fancy woollen wear is permitted.
- Students are expected to wear polished black leather shoes. Plain white shoes to be worn for P.E. only.
- Hair colouring, trendy hairstyles, hair cropped very short on the sides are unacceptable.
- Boys must have a hair - cut regularly and keep their hair short.

- Girls having shoulder length hair must tie their hair neatly using school or black rubber bands only. Hair below shoulder length should be neatly braided.
- Gold ornaments other than small ear studs for girls are not permitted.
- Nails must be neatly trimmed. Nail varnish is not permissible.
- Students enrolled for morning coaching or AAA need to bring and wear the appropriate change of shoes and clothes.
- The school reserves the right to have periodic uniform checks.
- The students who come in improper uniform will be asked to stand in a separate line and advised by the Supervisor and a note will be sent by the class teacher to the parent. If repeated, the students will be taken to the Vice Principal for further advice and action.

We request all parents to co-operate with us in establishing a culture of smartly turned out students across the school at all times. Together we can make a world of difference.
