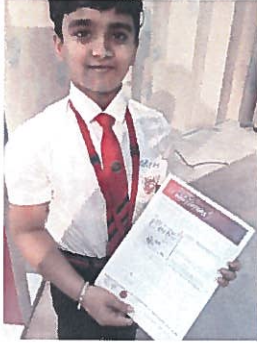

Students from Grade 2 collected Laban and Dates for workers in hospitals and construction sites to help them break the fast. At The Kindergarten Starters, Kindness Matters!



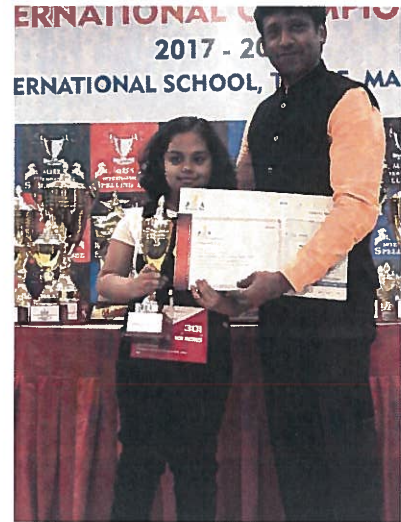
Congratulations Tatheer Inam for winning a prize at the International MARRS Spell Bee. We are all so proud of you!
